IMPORTANCE OF KEEPING THE MORAL PRECEPTS

When the Buddha taught groups of lay people, he would point out the importance of keeping the basic moral precepts. He explained that by doing that, their lives would be happy. In the accounts in the Pāli canon and commentaries of the past lives of many of the disciples of the Buddha, we can also see how important keeping the precepts is for happiness in future lives. And the horrendous suffering that results from breaking the precepts is vividly described.

A good example is the case of Venerable Ānanda. He had developed the ten perfections during countless lives, and at the time of the Buddha, he was the Buddha's attendant for far longer than any other attendant. It is thanks to his ability to remember whatever he heard that we have the discourses of the Buddha preserved in the Pāli texts.

However, as a result of associating with bad friends, there was an occasion in a past life when he had sexual relations with another man's wife. As a result of this he was born in a hell realm where he was tormented ceaselessly for countless thousands of years. In subsequent lives, he was castrated when he was born as animals: an ass, a monkey and an ox. Then he was born without a gender, neither a man nor woman.

It was only after numerous further rebirths in the deva and human worlds, where he could again make merit, that he finally received rebirth as a male.

Sayagyi showed how important proper relations amongst meditation students are: A student who was quite close to him began, in spite of being married, a romantic relationship with a woman who was also closely involved with the centre. Eventually he divorced his wife and married his lady friend. When Sayagyi heard about this, he immediately asked both of them to leave and not return to the centre. They were never allowed to return to Sayagyi. If trusted students have improper relations and are not controlled, other students will follow their example. Behaviour such as this will destroy the very fabric of the centre and will bring samādhi and the awareness of anicca down.

The world today is very treacherous for someone who wants to maintain even the basic moral precepts $(s\bar{\imath}la)$.
